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Application to Vote by Post

To be able to make a successful application to vote by post, your name must already be included in the Electoral Register for the address you show overleaf.

Please complete the form overleaf to show the information we require to be able to process your absent voting application. Please check the details carefully, enter your name, date of birth and signature in the relevant boxes and return to me at the address shown above.

Following a change in the law, which came into force on 8th February 2008, electors who wish to vote by post for any election on or after 8th August 2008, are now required to provide their date of birth and a specimen of their signature.

Your personal identifiers will be stored securely and will only be used at elections. The Returning Officer will compare these against the signature and date of birth that you will be required to provide on a Security Statement to be returned with your Postal Vote.

If you are unable to provide a signature, or you are unable to sign in a consistent or distinctive way because of any disability, or you are unable to read or write, please contact me at the address, telephone number or e-mail shown above. In these circumstances, I may grant you an exemption which will mean you will not be required to provide a signature.

Failure or refusal to provide the required personal identifiers will mean your absent voting arrangements cannot be completed and you will not be entitled to vote by post.

This will not prevent you from making a fresh application in the future.

Remember – You must complete and return this form to be able to vote by post.
